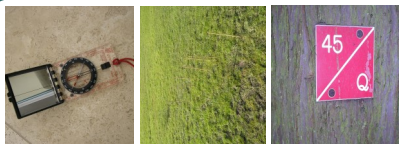

Orienteering & Navigation in Primary Schools

What does it involve?

This one day course will enable delegates to complete a series of activities to explore where direction comes from, how to use a map and compass, and how orienteering can be used in schools. By the end of the course they will have:

- Used a compass to navigate their way using simple directional instructions and measurements.
- Completed practical work on how to read maps, use symbols and create sketch maps.
- Completed different types of orienteering courses.
- Discussed how these ideas may be applied in their role.

In addition, we will explore links to the National Curriculum, topics and books / stories.
